Wraparound, Timely Community Health Support

Prevention, screening, and rapid re-housing
Community-based harm reduction, primary care, and mental health and addictions assessment and treatment
Staff who coordinate immediate and long-term support for youth with complex needs

- Have their healthcare and safety needs addressed
- Access stable, long-term housing
- Access education, life skills and other supports
